1) Each round robin group is ranked $1^{\text {st }}, 2^{\text {nd }}, 3^{\text {rd }}$ in their group based on Fina Tie breaking rules. https://www.fina.org/sites/default/files/2016-10-14 fina wp guide 2015-2017.pdf Section 6.6
2) Next the three first place teams are ranked $1,2,3$ based on:
a. Pts gained during round robin play, 2 pts per win, 1 pt per tie, 0 pts per loss.
b. Goal differential. Total of goals scored minus the goals scored on them
c. Total goals scored.
d. If still tied, then the ranking of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ place teams will be done next and the team from the pool of the higher ranked $2^{\text {nd }}$ place team will be ranked higher.
e. If still tied, then the ranking of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ place teams will be done next and the team from the pool of the higher ranked $3^{\text {rd }}$ place team will be ranked higher.
3) Next the three second place teams are ranked $4,5,6$ in the same way:
a. Pts gained during round robin play, 2 pts per win, 1 pt per tie, 0 pts per loss.
b. Goal differential. Total of goals scored minus the goals scored on them
c. Total goals scored.
d. If still tied, then the ranking of the $1^{\text {st }}$ place teams will be considered and the team from the pool of the higher ranked $1^{\text {st }}$ place team will be ranked higher.
e. If still tied, then the ranking of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ place teams will be done next and the team from the pool of the higher ranked $3^{\text {rd }}$ place team will be ranked higher.
4) Finally, the three third place teams are ranked $7,8,9$ in the same way:
a. Pts gained during round robin play, 2 pts per win, 1 pt per tie, 0 pts per loss.
b. Goal differential. Total of goals scored minus the goals scored on them
c. Total goals scored.
d. If still tied, then the ranking of the 1st place teams will be considered and the team from the pool of the higher ranked $1^{\text {st }}$ place team will be ranked higher.
e. If still tied, then the ranking of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ place teams will be done next and the team from the pool of the higher ranked $2^{\text {nd }}$ place team will be ranked higher.
5) Any ties remaining will be decided by a coin toss. The head coach can do the coin toss or designate someone else.
